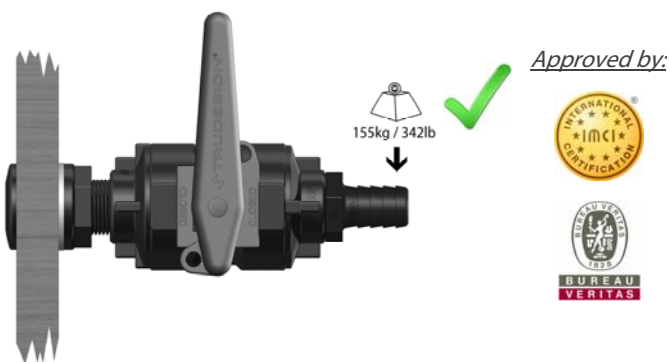

TRUDESIGN® Skin Fittings meet the American ABYC H-27 standard; *Seacocks, Thru-Hull Fittings, and Drain Plugs* – independently verified by Imanna Laboratory Inc.

ISO 9093-2 Standard



ISO 9093-2 requirements; a 1,500 N (155 kg / 341.7 lb) force is applied for 10 cycles to the most inward part of the assembly after which it should show no signs of damage and no leaks when subjected to an internal water pressure of 0.1 MPa (1 bar).

Note: 1/2" size Skin Fittings **not approved** to ISO 9093-2

ABYC H-27 Standard



ABYC H-27 requirements; a 500 lb (226.8 kg) load is applied to the inboard end of the assembly (i.e. from the Tail fitting) for a minimum of 30 seconds without any damage occurring.

Note: Applies to all sizes of TRUDESIGN® Skin Fittings assembled together with TRUDESIGN® Ball Valves and Load Bearing Collars
